### **Auterra Continues to Expand**

Schenectady, NY, June 25, 2013 - Schenectady County officials today announced that Auterra, a clean energy company, will move to 2135 Technology Drive in the City of Schenectady.

“We are pleased to welcome Auterra to Schenectady County,” said Marty Finn, Chairman of the County Legislature’s Committee on Economic Development and Planning. “Schenectady County has become a leader in attracting new investment into renewable energy and new technology business, and Auterra will be a great addition to our growing list of green energy companies.”

Auterra President and CEO Eric Burnett said, “We’re excited to be improving our physical space and capabilities with this move. The company’s oil upgrading technology is moving into the commercialization phase and having the more robust infrastructure will be very beneficial to accelerating our growth.”

Auterra has developed a patented catalytic process that enables energy companies to upgrade lower quality oil using less energy than existing technologies. The firm has been awarded six patents and has another nine patents under review.

The company is currently located in Malta but has outgrown its current space. Auterra considered a number of locations before selecting the 21,600 square foot building on Technology Drive in Schenectady.

The Schenectady County Metroplex Development Authority will provide a \$75,000 grant to assist with project costs.
